To ensure quality we are a juried event and only accept only Maine Made products, with limited numbers of artists in each category. For the past 5 years we have had over 1,200 shoppers through our doors. Every penny raised (after advertising) goes directly to the music students and their music trip at years end.

We offer a variety of **booth sizes** (see below). These sizes include your chair, and your way in and out of your space. Two artists can share a booth. Returning artist can choose their original spot, or request a new location, if their completed application is postmarked by June 1st. Care is taken to not put displays of the same art medium near each other and categories will close out when the correct amount of qualified crafters have registered.

Rules and Regulations

- **All artwork** must be an original or reproduction work of the artist. New applications must include a photograph (or web address) of their work in each medium for sale with their application as well as a picture of their set up.
- **New work** to be presented by the same artist in an ensuing year must be approved.
- **Maine made** products only.
- **Not for sale** work may be displayed if used to solicit commissions.
- Artists may **set up** either Friday night or Saturday morning (see application). Everyone must be ready for business by 8:30 and stay full set up until 3:00. *If you break down early you will not be invited back the next year.*
- Returning artists who submit all materials **by June 1st** can have the same space as the previous year or will have priority in requesting a new one. Requests will be handled on a first come first serve basis with an eye to keep similar crafters spaced appropriately.
- **Registration fee** must be paid before your space is secure.
- **Tables** can be rented for \$15 each and must be reserved prior to the show (*we have a limited number of tables*).
- **Artist vehicles** must be moved to the parking area after unloading and before set-up.
- **Each booth** must be within or meet the size you have been assigned, and includes your chair. *There are no spaces between the booths.*
- **Your display** should be designed, constructed and operated in good taste. You must supply all your own display materials and cover your table with a floor length table cloth.
- **Care** will be taken to not put displays of the same medium near each other.
- **Electricity** is only available on the stage or outside of the gym.
- **Wi-fi** is free and easily available for use.
